On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby Registered/Reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act.

A copy of the labeling accepted in connection with this Registration/Reregistration is returned herewith.

In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit/cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.
2. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 192-181" to the label prior to releasing the product for shipment.
3. The total percentage for the inert ingredients should be "98.9%", as was submitted on the previous label. Currently, the total active plus inert percentage exceeds 100%. Revise the percentages as appropriate.
4. Revise the last sentence in the ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS section of the product label to read as follows: Do not contaminate water by disposing of equipment washwaters.
5. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

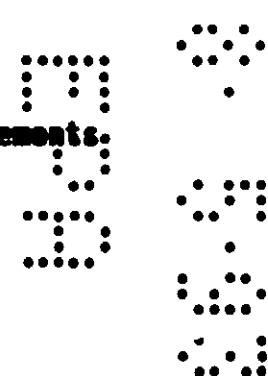

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product is for use around the home only.

USE IN HOMES, APARTMENTS, ATTICS, GARAGES, BASEMENTS AND STORAGE AREAS. KILLS ON CONTACT.

HOW TO USE: Shake well before using. Adjust spray nozzle to deliver a mist spray, or, for cracks and crevice treatment, adjust nozzle to deliver a fine stream spray. Hold container about 12 inches from pest, animal or surface to be treated. May be used indoors or outdoors. Hold container upright and spray infested surfaces until barely wet. Cover or remove all food and foodstuffs prior to treatment of the area. After treatment, thoroughly wash dishes, and food handling surfaces and utensils with soap and water prior to use.

INDOOR APPLICATIONS

To control cockroaches, palmetto bugs, ants, silverfish, spiders, crickets, clover mites, cheese mites, granary weevils, rice weevils, confused flour beetles, rust red flour beetles, saw-toothed grain beetles, spider beetles, cigarette beetles, drugstore beetles, meal worms, grain mites, and cadelles: Adjust the spray nozzle to give a mist spray. Direct the spray into hiding places, cracks and crevices, behind shelves and drawers, behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets, along baseboards, around door and window frames, into dark corners and in and around trash cans. For Ants, spray trails, nests and points of entry such as around doors and windows. **Pantry Pests:** Spray on shelves and in cupboards where food containers suspected of being infested are stored. Remove all food and shelving paper before spraying. Do not replace the food packages until spray had dried. Cover shelves with shelving paper. This treatment is supplemental to good housekeeping, since it will have no effect on insects breeding within food packages. Infested food packages should be destroyed. **Carpet Beetles:** Spray edges of carpeting and under carpets and rugs. Make localized application to floor and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks, crevices and infested areas of shelving. Repeat treatment as needed. **Bedbugs:** Spray mattresses lightly, particularly around tufts and seams. Take beds apart and spray in all joints. Treat baseboards, moldings and floors. Repeat treatment as needed. **Clothes Moths:** Remove any infested articles from storage, brush thoroughly and air for several hours in sunlight, if possible. Apply spray liberally to empty chests, closets, bureaus and other storages directing the spray into cracks, joints and crevices. After airing, infested articles may be treated lightly keeping nozzle at least three feet from fabric to avoid staining.

FLYING INSECTS: To control Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths & Gnats - Close doors, windows and shut off ventilating systems. Direct spray at an upward angle distributing it uniformly throughout the entire area. Do not remain in treated areas. If insects have not dropped to the floor in 3 minutes, repeat spraying as quantity sprayed was insufficient. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed. To aid in the prevention of breeding, spray around window screen and frames, screen doors, around outdoor lights, garbage cans, and other places where these insects alight or congregate.

For Flea & Tick Control on Dogs and Cats: Start spraying at the animal's head avoiding the eyes, nose and mouth as you spray. Make sure that the animal's entire body is covered, including the legs, under body and tail. While spraying, fluff the hair so that the spray will penetrate to the skin. Make sure spray

wets thoroughly. Avoid contact with genitalia. Do not use this product on puppies or kittens less than six weeks of age. Repeat as necessary.

Pet Areas: Thoroughly spray infested areas, pet beds, resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, moldings, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor covering. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Storage: To store, rotate nozzle to closed position. Store in a cool, dry place. Keep in original container and preferably in a locked storage area. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Do not store under 32°F.

Container Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash. **Pesticide Disposal:** Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating or smoking. Avoid contamination of feed or foodstuffs. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquaria before space spraying or surface applications.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Call a physician immediately. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **If Inhaled:** Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. **If on Skin:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water. **If In Eyes:** Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.
