House Plant Insect Killer controls Aphids, Twospotted Spider Mites, Fuchsia Mites, Mealybugs, Scale Crawlers and Whiteflies on the plants listed. Kills by contact action.

SHAKE THOROUGHLY BEFORE USE.

When to Apply - Spray at first signs of insects, before infestation is heavy. Repeat as necessary. Do not apply more frequently than every 7 days. Do not apply to wilted or water stressed plants or plants that are in direct sunlight. For harder-to-control pests as noted below, 2 to 3 applications at 7 to 10 day intervals may be necessary.

How to Apply - Hold container 6" to 8" from the plant and pump with the nozzle directed at the pests on the leaves. Spray to completely cover insects on upper and lower leaf surfaces. Avoid overwetting foliage. Plants may be sprayed indoors. Avoid spraying blossoms as discoloration may occur.

*On these harder-to-kill pests, repeat applications 1-2 more times at 7 to 10 day intervals after the initial treatment.

Storage and Disposal
