Nests located around children's play areas or in locations where individuals allergic to bee stings may be exposed are undesirable and should be removed. To rid certain areas of these pests, use Dexol Hornet & Wasp Killer II as directed below.

FOR CONTROL OF HORNETS, WASPS AND YELLOW JACKETS (OUTDOOR USE ONLY): It is preferable to apply Dexol Hornet & Wasp Killer II after dark when all insects have returned to the nest. Remove cap and hold can in an upright position while spraying. Hold can at arm's length, aim valve opening at nest and depress button. Spray to soak the entire nest with product. Repeat as necessary to maintain control.

IMPORTANT: DO NOT spray plant foliage as injury may occur. DO NOT use this product
