Dexol Indoor Insect Fogger II effectively kills Fleas, Roaches, Spiders, Ants, Crickets, Flies, Ticks, Mosquitoes, Pill Bugs, Small Flying Moths, Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles and Weevils. Use in homes, apartments, attics, basements, campers, boats, garages, pet sleeping areas, cabins and household storage areas. When used as directed, this product will not harm drapes, upholstery, fabrics, carpeting, bedspreads, clothing, linen, furniture, walls, floor tiles, ceilings, shades and blinds.

Use one 6 oz. container to treat 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area (or, one 5 oz. container to treat 5,000 cubic feet). Use additional containers for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured.

##### SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

1. Cover exposed food, dishes, and food handling equipment. Open cabinets and closet doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows.
2. Place the fogger on a stand or table in the center of the room. Remove any items close to the fogger that may obstruct the spray. Place several layers of newspaper or pad beneath the fogger to prevent marring of surface.
3. Point can away from face and eyes and lock valve in the open position for automatic discharge. Leave building at once and keep building closed for 2 hours before returning.
4. After 2 hours, open all doors and windows and allow treated area to air for

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30 minutes. Repeat application in two weeks or when necessary to maintain control of insect infestations.

**To Effectively Control Fleas and Ticks:** Remove and destroy old pet bedding. Use product as directed above. Put fresh bedding in pet quarters after treatment. Treat dogs and cats with a flea and tick product registered for direct use on pets.
