**SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING**

**General:** Apply this product as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control cockroaches, fleas, silverfish, ticks, waterbugs and other insects listed below. Apply this product as a coarse spray or crack and crevice treatment to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Repeat as needed.

**To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Spiders, Sowbugs, and Carpet Beetles:** Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly.

**For Ants:** Apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests can find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

**To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas:** Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, windows and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. **DO NOT SPRAY PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT.**

**To Kill Flies and Mosquitoes:** Use only out of doors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of windows and doorframes as well as other areas where these pests enter the home. Also, spray dark corners and localized resting areas (such as under eaves) or porches, patios and garages where these insects may congregate.
