This product has been carefully designed to provide an optimal balance of pesticide effectiveness and low phytotoxicity (harmfulness to plants). Dexol Dormant & Summer Oil Spray II does not poison insects. Instead it impedes the respiratory process of eggs, larvae, and other insect life forms, causing hypoxia, i.e., suffocation. The great advantage of this physical mechanism is that insects cannot develop resistance to the product.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE. Apply as a thorough spray wetting pests and all plant parts. Unless otherwise directed, fill the spray tank with $\frac{1}{2}$ the required amount of water. Add the recommended amount of Dexol Dormant & Summer Oil Spray II and finish filling spray tank with water.

PLANT RESPONSE PRECAUTIONS: DO NOT apply this product when temperatures exceed 90°F within 24 hours after treatment. DO NOT apply this product to plants within 30 days before or after using sulphur. DO NOT apply to plants that are stressed due to drought, disease or drying winds. DO NOT apply to Maidenhair ferns, Cocos Palms, Red Maple or non-woody plants unless specified on this label. FOR DORMANT USE- For control of Scale Insects, Spider Mites and Mealybugs on Dormant Shrubs, Evergreens (Note Plant Response Precautions), Woody Plants, Fruit and Nut Trees (Almonds, Apples, Plums, Pears, Apricots, Peaches, Cherries, Nectarines, Olives) and Shade Trees: Use 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ fl. oz. per 1 gallon water. **GROWING SEASON-** For control of Scale Insects, Spider Mites, Mealybugs, and Whitefly larvae on Citrus (Oranges, Lemons, Grapefruit, Tangerines, Limes), Fruit and Nut Trees (Almonds, Apples, Plums, Pears, Apricot, Peaches, Cherries, Prunes, Nectarines, Olives), Shade Trees, Evergreens, Camellias, Azaleas, Hardy Shrubs: Use 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ fl. oz. (5 tablespoons) per 1 gallon of water. This application is also effective in the control of Whitefly Larvae and removal of sooty mold fungus.

COMBINATION WINTER SPRAY- Fruit Trees (Apples, Plums, Pears, Peaches, Cherries), Roses and Ornamentals (Dormant deciduous only) – for control of San Jose scale, Rose scale, Oyster Shell scale, Black scale and Overwintering insect eggs: Use 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ fl. oz. (5 tablespoons) of Dexol Dormant & Summer Oil Spray II within combination with 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ fl. oz. (5 tablespoons) Lime-Sulphur spray. Note any plant response precautions on Lime-Sulphur spray label prior to making applications.

HOME GREENHOUSES- For control of Scale Insects, Spider mites, Whiteflies, Mealybugs, on Hardy Shrubs, Gardenias, Camellias and Azaleas- Use 2 tablespoons (1 fl. oz.) per 1 gallon of water. Allow at least 2 months between treatments. Do not make more than 3 treatments per year.

PALM TREES- Scale Insects, Mealybugs, Spider mites- Use 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ fl. oz. (3 tablespoons) per 1 gallon water. Note plant response precautions.

AZALEAS, CAMELLIAS- Scale Insects, Spider mites, Mealybugs, Whitefly Larvae, Lace bug larvae- Use 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ fl. oz. (5 tablespoons) per 1 gallon of water. Apply in spring after blooming and in fall prior to blooming.

AS A LEAF POLISH- To improve the luster of leaves of hardy house plants, use 3 tablespoons (1 $\frac{1}{2}$ fl. oz.) per gal. of water. Wash leaves gently with solution using a soft cloth or sponge.

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Storage and Disposal

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. Keep in original container and preferably in a locked storage area inaccessible to children and pets. Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs.
