Dear Ms. Crawford:

The revised labeling referenced above, submitted in connection with the registration under the Federal Insecticide, fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) as amended, is acceptable with the following comments:

- 1) Add "For Residential Use only" or "For Homeowners Use Only" under the product name.
- 2) Other ingredients should be listed at 2% and not at 02%.
- 3) Delete the section AS A LEAF POLISH at the bottom of page 2-only insecticidal claims allowed.
- 4) Delete "For terrestrial uses" from the Environmental Hazards section since only terrestrial uses are listed on the label.
- 5) Delete "This product has been carefully designed to provide and optimal balance of pesticide effectiveness" and "the great advantage"
- 6) The Directions for Use must be corrected to state "This product is product is for use on plants grown in and around the home".

A stamped copy "accepted with comments" of the label is enclosed for your records.

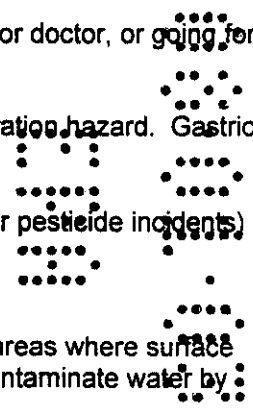

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. For terrestrial uses, do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present, or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of washwaters.



PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use or store near open flame.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **This product is for use on plants grown in and the home as directed below. Do not apply this product to sites or areas not listed or prohibited on this label.**

This product has been carefully designed to provide an optimal balance of pesticide effectiveness and low phytotoxicity (harmfulness to plants). Dexol Dormant & Summer Oil Spray II does not poison insects. Instead it impedes the respiratory process of eggs, larvae, and other insect life forms, causing hypoxia, i.e., suffocation. The great advantage of this physical mechanism is that insects cannot develop resistance to the product.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE. Apply as a thorough spray wetting pests and all plant parts. Unless otherwise directed, fill the spray tank with 1/2 the required amount of water. add the recommended amount of Dexol Dormant & Summer Oil Spray II and finish filling spray tank with water.

PLANT RESPONSE PRECAUTIONS: DO NOT apply this product when temperatures exceed 90°F within 24 hours after treatment. DO NOT apply this product to plants within 30 days before or after using sulphur. DO NOT apply to plants that are stressed due to drought, disease or drying winds. DO NOT apply to Maidenhair ferns, Cocos Palms, Red Maple or non-woody plants unless specified on this label. DO NOT apply to broadleaved evergreens or palms when freezing temperatures may be expected. May cause discoloration of Blue Spruce. Do not use in combination with products containing Captan fungicide. DO NOT mix with insecticides of fungicides incompatible with oil. Consult your state Agricultural Extension Service for specific compatibilities.

FOR DORMANT USE- For control of Scale Insects, Spider Mites and Mealybugs on Dormant Shrubs, Evergreens (Note Plant Response Precautions), Woody Plants, Fruit and Nut Trees (Almonds, Apples, Plums, Pears, Apricots, Peaches, Cherries, Nectarines, Olives) and Shade Trees: Use 5 1/2 fl. oz. per 1 gallon water. **GROWING SEASON-** For control of Scale Insects, Spider Mites, Mealybugs, and Whitefly larvae on Citrus(Oranges, Lemons, Grapefruit, Tangerines, Limes), Fruit and Nut Trees (Almonds, Apples, Plums, Pears, Apricot, Peaches, Cherries, Prunes, Nectarines, Olives), Shade Trees, Evergreens, Camellias, Azaleas, Hardy Shrubs: Use 2 1/2 fl. oz. (5 tablespoons) per 1 gallon of water. This application is also effective in the control of Whitefly Larvae and removal of sooty mold fungus.

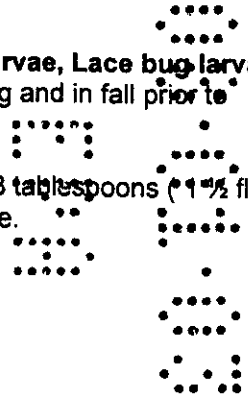
COMBINATION WINTER SPRAY- Fruit Trees (Apples, Plums, Pears, Peaches, Cherries), Roses and Ornamentals (Dormant deciduous only) – for control of San Jose scale, Rose scale, Oyster Shell scale, Black scale and Overwintering insect eggs: Use 2 1/2 fl. oz. (5 tablespoons) of Dexol Dormant & Summer Oil Spray II within combination with 2 1/2 fl. oz. (5 tablespoons) Lime-Sulphur spray. Note any plant response precautions on Lime-Sulphur spray label prior to making applications.

HOME GREENHOUSES- For control of Scale Insects, Spider mites, Whiteflies, Mealybugs, on Hardy Shrubs, Gardenias, Camellias and Azaleas- Use 2 tablespoons (1 fl. oz.) per 1 gallon of water. Allow at least 2 months between treatments. Do not make more than 3 treatments per year.

PALM TREES- Scale Insects, Mealybugs, Spider mites- Use 1 1/2 fl. oz. (3 tablespoons) per 1 gallon water. Note plant response precautions.

AZALEAS, CAMELLIAS- Scale Insects, Spider mites, Mealybugs, Whitefly Larvae, Lace bug larvae- Use 2 1/2 fl. oz. (5 tablespoons) per 1 gallon of water. Apply in spring after blooming and in fall prior to blooming.

AS A LEAF POLISH- To improve the luster of leaves of hardy house plants, use 3 tablespoons (1 1/2 fl. oz.) per gal. of water. Wash leaves gently with solution using a soft cloth or sponge.



Storage and Disposal
