On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 192-198

b. Replace The Hazards To Humans & Domestic Animals section with " Wash thoroughly after handling and before smoking or eating. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquaria before surface applications. Do not use on humans. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated areas until surfaces are dry."

c. Under INDOOR USE add "with "For spot application only. Do not use as a space spray indoors."

d. Under **INDOOR USE** delete "with no lingering oily odor." A false or misleading comparison with other pesticides is not acceptable.

e. Delete **House flies and mosquitoes** section. These pests do not appear on the reference label. If you want to retain these pests, you must submit a new Offer-To-Pay Statement using the Cite-All Method of Support.

f. Although this product is ready to use it is not clear if it can be applied from the original container. We discourage marketing of pesticides for indoor general use unless they are ready to use and applied from the original container. This prevent the homeowner from using outdoor spray equipment to apply the product, unlabeled windex bottles, etc. If a spray head trigger is not marketed with this product add the following statement:

"Affix trigger, pump or other types of sprayer to container for application. Do not transfer to another container."

3. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: May be harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Wash thoroughly after handling. Avoid contamination of food, feedstuffs and domestic water supplies.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is extremely toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label. Cover aquariums and terrariums before spraying.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For Household use only: For use in homes, apartments, attics, basements, campers, boats, household storage areas, garages, pet sleeping areas, cabins.

Indoor Use: For residual and contact control of: **COCKROACHES, WATERBUGS, PALMETTO BUGS, SCORPIONS, MILLIPEDES, CENTIPEDES, SOWBUGS, PILLBUGS, ANTS, SILVERFISH, FIREBRATS, SPIDERS, CRICKETS, CLOVER MITES, CHEESE MITES, GRANARY WEEVILS, RICE WEEVILS, CONFUSED FLOUR BEETLES, RUST RED FLOUR BEETLES, DRUGSTORE BEETLES, MEALWORMS, GRAIN MITES AND CADELLES.** Continues to kill and protect for up to 4 weeks with no lingering oily odor.

Cockroaches (Waterbugs), Ants, Silverfish: Make spot applications of **Dexol Multipurpose Insect Spray** to baseboards, areas around water pipes, cracks and crevices, surfaces behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, and similar areas where these insects hide. **Ants:** To kill ants, spray trails, nests and points of entry within buildings and homes. Spray directly on insects where possible. Repeat application as necessary to maintain control.

Carpet beetles: Spray in spot applications along baseboards and edges of carpeting, under carpeting, rugs and furniture, in closets and on shelving, and wherever these insects are seen or suspected.

Spiders and Scorpions: Spray around windows, doors, and along baseboards. Make spot applications to other areas over which these pests may crawl.

Bedbugs: Spray mattresses lightly, particularly around tufts and seams. Take beds apart and spray in all joints. Treat baseboards, moldings and floors. Repeat treatment as needed.

Brown dog ticks, Fleas*: Apply to infested areas around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, sleeping quarters of household pets, and localized areas of floors and floor coverings. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. NOTE: Always spot test for color fastness of surfaces prior to making a full treatment. Repeat as necessary.

On Dogs: Start spraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidly and making sure that the animal's entire body is covered, including the legs and under-body. While spraying, fluff the hair so that the spray will penetrate to the skin. Make sure spray wets thoroughly, but do not saturate animal. Do not spray into eyes or face. Avoid contact with genitalia. Repeat as necessary.

*Controls adult fleas on areas treated.

NOTE: Not recommended for use on puppies less than four weeks old. DO NOT USE ON CATS OR KITTENS.

Pantry Pests - Exposed Stages (Sawtoothed Grain Beetle, Flour Beetle, Rice Weevil, Cigarette Beetle, Drugstore Beetle, Indian Meal Moth): Spray Dexol Multipurpose Insect Spray on shelves and in cupboards where food containers suspected of being infested are stored. Remove all food and shelving paper before spraying. Do not replace the food packages until spray has dried. Cover shelves with shelving paper. This treatment is supplemental to good housekeeping, since it will have no effect on insects breeding within food packages. Infested food packages should be destroyed.

Clothes Moths: Remove any infested articles from storage, brush thoroughly, and air for several hours in sunlight, if possible. Apply spray liberally to empty chests, closets, bureaus and other storage directing the spray into cracks, joints and crevices. After airing, infested articles may be treated lightly, keeping nozzle at least three feet from fabric to avoid staining.

Lice and Louse Eggs: Spray in an inconspicuous area to test for possible staining or discoloration. Inspect again after drying, then proceed to spray entire area to be treated. Spray from a distance of 8-10 inches. **Treat only** those garments and parts of bedding, including mattresses and furniture that cannot be either laundered or dry cleaned. Allow all treated articles to dry thoroughly before use.

OUTDOOR USE: Use this product to control **Cockroaches, Waterbugs, Palmetto Bugs, Scorpions, Millipedes, Centipedes, Sowbugs, Pillbugs, Ants, Silverfish, Firebrats, Spiders, Crickets, Clover Mites, and Cadelles.** To help prevent infestation of building, treat the building foundation to a height of 2-3 feet, where pests are active and may find entrance. Also apply as a residual spray to outside surfaces of building, including porches, screens, window frames, eaves, patios, garages, refuse dumps, and other areas where these pests congregate or have been seen. Repeat treatment as needed to maintain effectiveness.

Ticks: To help control ticks in outdoor activity areas, treat a band of vegetation 6-8 feet wide and adjacent to activity areas, especially where dense vegetation occurs.

House flies and mosquitoes: For use only as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames or wherever these insects may enter the room. Also treat surfaces around light fixtures on porches, in garages and other places where these insect alight or congregate. Repeat as necessary.

GARDEN INSECTS: Use this product to control **Whiteflies, Aphids, Spider and Red Mites, Exposed Thrips, Lace Bugs, Japanese Beetles, Pavement Ants, Clover Mites, Armyworms and Leafminers;** on African violets, asters, azaleas, begonias, camellias, carnations, chrysanthemums, dahlias, delphiniums, dogwoods, English ivy, eunonymus, fuschia, geraniums, crassula. grape vines, Kentia palms, laurels, marigolds, rhododendrons, roses, rubber plants, snapdragons, stocks, wandering jews, and zinnias. Spray at first sight of insects, before infestation is heavy. Repeat as necessary. When spraying plants, do not operate closer than 18 inches. Use sweeping motion. Be cautions about wetting tender foliage, young plants, and new growth. Do not spray plants when temperatures exceed 90°F. Contact insect directly whenever possible. Repeat treatment as infestations occur.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. Keep in original container and preferably in a locked storage area inaccessible to children and pets. **Disposal:** Do not reuse empty container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
