Use Restrictions: For use against pocket gophers in home lawns. Do not apply in gardens and; areas where food or feed may be contaminated. Only apply the bait underground. Collect and bury all dead animals found above the ground. This product is to be used in manual applications only. Do not apply this product by use of an artificial burrow builder.

Specific Directions for Pocket Gophers: Burrowing pocket gophers (Thomomys spp. and Geomys spp.) throw out low, fan shaped mounds on either side of their underground tunnel. These lateral tunnels coming to the surface are on the flat side of the fan and are plugged with soil. To locate underground runways: Use a metal rod, a strong smooth stick or other suitable instrument to probe the ground 10-15 inches away from fan-shaped gopher mounds. Begin probing on the flat side of the fan. When the main runway has been entered, the probe will drop about 2 inches due to decreased resistance from the soil. Using a long-handled spoon or mechanical probe, drop one teaspoon of Dexol Gopher Killer Pellets 2 into the main runway at each baited point. Cover the opening with sod, a rock, or soil to exclude light. Take care not to cover bait with soil. Depending upon mound density, make two to five bait placements per burrow system. Recover and bury all spilled pellets.
