Reregistration under this section does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of your product.

Make the following labeling changes before you release the product for shipment:

1. The "First Aid" instructions must be printed on the front panel of the product label.
2. Change the dosage level given in the "Sanitization of Non-Porous Food Contact Surfaces" to: "2.5 oz. of this product".
3. Change the dosage level given in the "Disinfection Of Drinking Water (Emergency/Public/Individual)" instructions, subheading "Public Systems", to: "2.5 oz. of this product". In the "Emergency Disinfection" subheading, change the dosage level to "3 drops of this product".
