The revised product label forwarded in response to EPA's letter of March 7, 1994 and the revised Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) for the subject formulation have been reviewed and the following applies.

1. The revised product labeling, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records. Submit five copies of the final printed labels which includes these comments before releasing the product for shipment.

a. Insert an Environmental Hazards statement in accordance with PR Notice 93-10: "This product is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. For all outdoor uses of this product listed on this label (i.e., swimming pools): Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA."

2. The revised CSF is agrees with the product label, complies with PR Notice 91-2 and is satisfactory.
