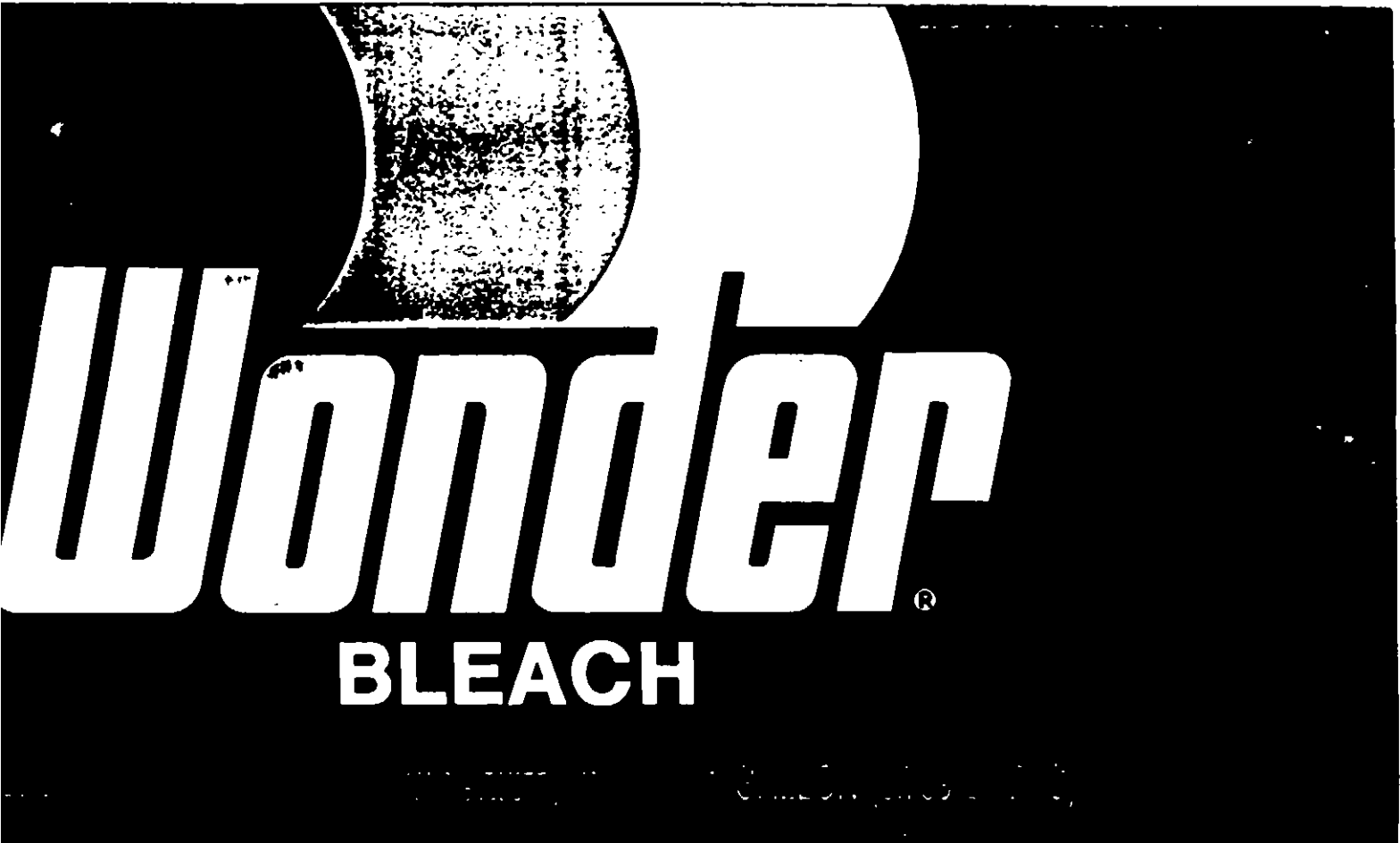

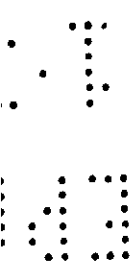

Wonder

Your laundry needs Wonder bleach:

For the broad range of laundry problems, no other detergent additive can give a cleaner, brighter wash.

Pre-treat stains and soils: Stubborn stains may be soaked for 5 minutes in a solution of ¼ cup bleach in 1 gallon of cool soapy water.

Removing stains: For stubborn stains due to coffee, tea, oil, grass, fruit, soot, ink, etc., mix ¼ cup bleach in 1 quart of water. Use porcelain, glass or rubber container. Soak stained area for 5 minutes—rinse thoroughly. Repeat if necessary. If brown spots are left after removing rust or ink stains, they can usually be removed with lemon juice or vinegar. Dry in sunlight.

Sort laundry by color and fabric: Separate whites from colors, light colors from dark ones. Avoid bleaching wool, silk, mohair, leather, spandex, non-fast colors and flame retardant cotton fabrics.

For age yellowed nylons: Mix 2 tablespoons of bleach to one gallon of warm water; add 1 teaspoon of household vinegar. Soak nylon for 15 minutes. Repeat if necessary. Rinse thoroughly.

Add bleach and detergent: Bleach may be added to the wash water before laundry is put in or, for best results, dilute with a quart of water and add 5 or 6 minutes after the wash cycle has begun. Use the recommended amount of bleach. For heavily soiled items or very large loads, add slightly more.



Directions for household use:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Disinfection of bath tubs, showers, kitchen sinks: Prepare a disinfecting solution by thoroughly mixing 1.5 oz. of this product with 1 gallon of water to provide approximately 600 ppm available chlorine by weight. Clean surfaces in the normal manner. Prior to use, rinse all surfaces thoroughly with the disinfecting solution, maintaining contact with the solution at least 10 minutes. Do not rinse surfaces with water after treatment and do not soak overnight.



To sanitize your laundry:

In soaking mode: Thoroughly mix 5 oz. of this product to 10 gallons of wash water to provide 200 ppm available chlorine. Wait 5 minutes, then add soap or detergent. Immerse laundry for at least 11 minutes prior to starting the wash/rinse cycle.

In washing mode: Thoroughly mix 5 oz. of this product to 10 gallons of wash water containing clothes to provide 200 ppm available chlorine. Wait 5 minutes, then add soap or detergent and start the wash/rinse cycle.

Immediately remove contaminated clothing and wash with plenty of soap and water. If Swallowed: Drink large quantities of milk, gelatin solution or water. DO NOT give vinegar or other acids. DO NOT induce vomiting. Get prompt medical attention.

Physical and chemical hazards: Strong oxidizing agent. Do not use or mix with other household chemicals such as toilet bowl cleaners or products containing vinegar, acids or ammonia. To do so will release hazardous gases. Do not use for food or water treatment. Prolonged contact with metal may cause pitting or discoloration.
