FOR EXTERNAL USE ONLY!

AS A GROOM: Apply QUADINE sparingly to dog's coat with atomizer, brush, or cloth. Massage the QUADINE right down to the skin, into roots of the hairs, with finger tips. Brush coat well. Do this twice a week.

KEEP CONTAINER WELL CAPPED WHEN NOT IN USE!

FOR CONTROL of FLEAS, LICE - and As DEODORANT: Spray dogs sparingly! Spray premises, equipment, bedding, and runways liberally with QUADINE. Leave well ventilated for some hours after use. In stubborn cases of re-infestation, repeated spraying of everything in contact with dog is necessary.

FOR CONTROL of SARCOPTIC MANGE MITES: Spray QUADINE on infected areas as often as necessary. Several applications may be needed.

FOR CONTROL of EAR MANGE MITES: Carefully cleanse ear, then apply QUADINE. Repeated applications usually are required.

TO REPEL MOSQUITOES - Similar Biting INSECTS: Spray dog sparingly as often as needed. **FOR CHIGGERS:** Apply promptly after exposure.

TO TREAT MINOR CUTS, SCRATCHES, SORES, WOUNDS, BRUISES, BURNS: Apply QUADINE directly upon the sore or wound. Do not bandage!

WARNING Do NOT use on puppies under 6 weeks old! On puppies over 6 weeks age, use very sparingly and after application, keep them separated and in open air for at least a day. If allowed to huddle together after use, the volatile gases can make them nauseous or seriously ill. NOTE: Under no circumstances should QUADINE be applied heavily over animal's body, as such over-use may be harmful!

Always use sparingly, in plenty of fresh air!
