material preparation

- Mix thoroughty, stirring with a smooth, lifting motion to assure color uniformity
- Apply untrinned for one coat application.
- If necessary (when applying two coats), fitst coat may be thinned with ug to one gint of paint thinner (mineral spirits) per gallon of stain. Do not thin with water oils, other stains or paints.
- May be tinted with 0RAMATONE Multi.Purpose Colorants only, as specified in Cliden color literature.

SURFACE PREPARATION

- General and for New Wood-All surfaces must be dry. well cured and cleaned of dust, dirt, out, wax or any other contaminants that might affect adhesion or performance.
- Remove mildew-scrub with sofution of one tablespoon dry powdered laundry detergent and one quant hypochlorite-type household bleach to three quarts warm water. Ri..se
thoroughly with water. Wear protective glasses and rubher gloves to avoid eye and skin irsitation. Make sure all surfaces are iniernally dry.
- Previously Stained-Use this product over old semi-fransparent stain only. NOTE: The original color will be deepened by a new application of this stain even when it is ctosely matched to the new color.


## APPIICATION

- One gallon covers approximately $\mathbf{2 0 0 . 3 0 0}$ scuare feet on smooth surfaces and atout $\mathbf{1 5 0 . 2 0 0}$ square feet on rough surfaces.
- Use on exterior surfaces only. Stir ftequently during application.
- Always pretest on an inconspicuous area to assure desired results. Apply carefully to avoid dark lap marks.
- Stain is best applied by brushing, working well into surface. Roller and pad application should be supplemenazd by brushing to fill eravices. Spray at only $15-20$ lbs. pressure to avoid frothing. Use spray masks or hoods.
- Do not appiy when surface or atmospheric temperatures are less than $50{ }^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$.
- Dries to touch in 6.8 hours under normal conditions ( $70^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$., $50 \%$ R. H .). Recoat after 12 hours minimum. May be walked upon after drying 16 hours minimum.
- Clean toofs and equipment with No, 60 SPRED ${ }^{3}$ Brush \& Roller Cleaner or paint thinrer (mineral spirits).
