

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS: To avoid spontaneous combustion, soak only cloths in water after use or place in a closed metal container away from buildings and other combustible materials. COMSUSTIBLE. Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

A durable water repellent semi-transparent, exterior stain to control fungal decay of wood. For above-ground use only. Penetrates into the wood to protect and enhance the wood grain beauty of all types of wood, decks and fencing. Lumber pretreated with commercial preservatives should weather one season to minimize discoloration and/or lifting of the stain. DO NOT USE ON PAINTED SURFACES.

Do not use on wood that will be used in contact with food, feed or potable water or where prolonged skin contact will occur. Due to the presence of petroleum distillates in this product, do not use on lumber where dairy cattle or ilvestock can come in contact with the treated wood.

NOTE: DRAMATONE Colorant must be added to Tint Base before application. See Glidden color literature.

MATERIAL PREPARATION

 Mix thoroughly stirring with a smooth, lifting motion to assure color uniformity.

*Apply unthinned for one coat application.

• if necessary (when applying two coats), first coat may be thinned with up to one pint of paint thinner (mineral spirits) per gallon of stain. Do not thin with water, oils, other stains or paints.

*May be tinted with DRAMATONE Muiti-Purpose Colorants only, as specified in Gildden color literature.

SURFACE PREPARATION

*General and fur New Wood - All surfaces must be dry, well cured and cleaned of dust, dirt, oll, wax or any other contaminants that might affect adhesion or performance.

*Remove mildew - scrub with solution of one tablespoon dry powdered laundry detergent and one quart hypochlorite-type household bleach to three quarts warm water. Rinse thoroughly with water. Wear protective glasses and rubber gloves to avoid eye and skin irritation. Make sure all rurfaces are internally dry.

*Previously Stained - Use this product over old semi-transparent stain only. NOTE: The original color will be deepened by a new application of this stain even when it is closely matched to the $\sqrt{}$ new color.

For best results and uniformity of appearance, retreat once every three years.

APPLICATION

*One gallon covers approximately 200-300 square feet on smooth surfaces, about 150-200 square feet on rough surfaces.

*Use on exterior surfaces only. Stir frequently during application.

*Always pretest on an inconspicuous area to assure desired results. Apply carefully to avoid dark lap marks.

*Stain is best applied by brushing, working well into surface. Roller and pad application should be supplemented by brushing to fill crevices. Spray at only 15-20 lbs. pressure to avoid frothing. When spraying wear respiratory protection (NIOSH/MSHA TC23C) chemical cartridge or equivalent.

*Do not apply when surface or atmospheric temperatures are less than 50°F.

Dries to touch in 6-8 hours under normal conditions (70° F., 60% R.H.). Recoat after 12 hours minimum. May be walked upon after drying 16 hours minimum. *Cut wood prior to treatment if possible. If not, liberally apply two coatings of preservative to all joints, cracks, cut-ends, holes or other openings.

*Applying wood finishes often results in splashing or dripping. Cover desirable plants and shrubs to protect against possible Injury.

*Clean tools and equipment with No. 60 GLIDDEN Brush & Roller Cleaner or paint thinner (mineral spirits).
