

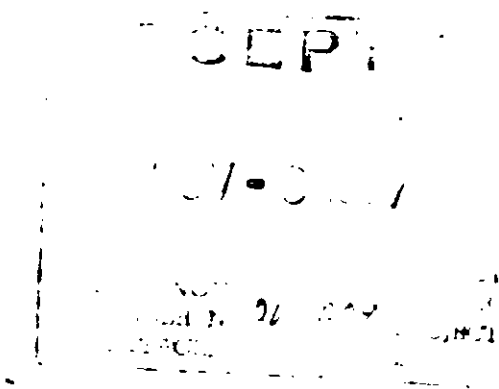

PRECAUTIONS IN USING

WARNING! POISONOUS IF SWALLOWED, INHALED OR ABSORBED THROUGH SKIN. RAPIDLY ABSORBED THROUGH SKIN; REPEATED INHALATION OR SKIN CONTACT MAY, WITHOUT SYMPTOMS, PROGRESSIVELY INCREASE SUSCEPTIBILITY TO BIDRIN POISONING.

Do not swallow or get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Do not breathe vapors.

Keep out of the reach of children and domestic animals. Do not contaminate food or feedproducts. Keep away from heat and open flame.

Wear clean natural rubber gloves, clean protective clothing, and goggles. Replace gloves frequently and destroy used gloves. During commercial or prolonged exposure in spray-mixing and loading operations, wear a mask or respirator of a type adequate against BIDRIN vapors and gases. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. If the material gets into the eyes, immediately flush with water for at least ten minutes and get medical attention. In case of accidental contact, remove all contaminated clothing and wash skin with soap and water; wash clothing before re-use. In case of spillage, wash down with large amounts of water.

This product is toxic to wildlife. Keep out of lakes, ponds, and streams. Do not apply in any manner not specified on the label. Birds and other wildlife in treated areas may be killed.

Decontaminate areas and equipment by washing with concentrated solution of alkali and detergent and rinse with water.

Note: Caution. Avoid skin and eye contamination when handling strong caustic solution.

DECONTAMINATE AND DESTROY USED CONTAINERS. Do not re-use for any purpose. Decontaminate containers by rinsing thoroughly with water and alkaline detergent. Destroy containers by breaking and burying fragments in isolated area. Dispose of rinsings in a way as not to constitute a hazard, or contaminate water supplies.

GENERAL DIRECTIONS

For foliage applications, mix the required amount of BIDRIN Insecticide Emulsible Concentrate and water together. Apply as a spray to provide uniform coverage.

DIRECTIONS FOR APPLICATION

TO BE APPLIED BY TRAINED APPLICATORS ONLY. (Professional Arborists and Nurserymen).

Make applications when the insect first appears or when damage is observed, applying it to the point of drip. Consult State Agricultural Experiment Stations for proper timing.

DO NOT USE THIS PRODUCT FOR IMPLANT TREATMENT OF TREES OR ORNAMENTALS. DILUENTS MAY CAUSE SEVERE INJURY TO INFECTED PLANTS.
