

PRECAUTIONS IN USING

WARNING!

USE AND DIRECTIONS FOR APPLICATION

1% VAPONA® Insecticide Dust should be applied immediately after harvest to obtain thorough coverage of the fruit in lug boxes, hampers or other containers. The VAPONA should be applied at the rate of 1 lb of the 1% Dust per ton of fruit.

If treatment can not be made at this time, or if additional fruit damage occurs in the transit, the fruit should be retreated at the same dosage rate at the receiving station or cannery yard.
