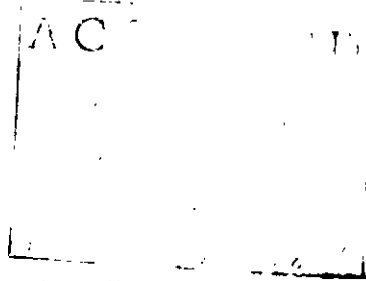

Atropine is the specific antidote for poisoning by cholinergic agents. It should be given as soon as possible.

INTERNAL: If the patient has been poisoned, give atropine immediately. If the patient is unconscious, give atropine immediately.
