GENERAL DIRECTIONS

PLANAVIN 75 controls susceptible annual grasses and broadleaf weeds without injury to established ornamentals when applied according to directions. It can be used to control weeds in ornamentals. Apply PLANAVIN 75 in a broadcast or spot application. Apply 2.5 pounds per acre of PLANAVIN 75 on sand and sandy, heavy soils; 1 pound on loams; 1-1.5 pounds on silty and clayey soils with organic matter; and 2 pounds on heavier organic soil and clay soils. With artificial mixtures of soil and for control of weeds in ornamentals, increase the rate to 4 pounds of PLANAVIN 75 per acre. Do not use PLANAVIN 75 in areas where soil is not moist.
