DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Hook flea tag to dog's collar and pinch "S" hook together. Flea kill begins at once and will continue for 90 days while the tag is worn. Ticks are harder to kill, but those in neck area only will be killed in a short period after the tag is attached. For continuous protection, replace tag every 90 days. For dogs over 50 lbs. use two tags.

CAUTION: Do not open protective pouch until ready to use. Do not allow children to play with tag. Tag is intended for use only as an insecticide generator (Shell's U.S. Patents 2,956,073, 3,116,201 and 3,318,769), and is not to be taken internally by man or animals. Do not use on sick or convalescing dogs. Do not use on cats, whippets or greyhounds. Do not use other pesticides on dogs while tag is worn. Remove the tag if any adverse reactions are observed. Some animals may be sensitive to this produce.
