GENERAL DIRECTIONS

Shell's Turkey Leg Bands are specially prepared to control the turkey chigger, Neoschongastia americana, by continuous controlled release of the insecticide. For optimum results apply leg band five to six weeks before intended marketing.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Place one (1) band around one (1) leg of each bird and close with a double o (00) hog ring or with a poultry cage ring using regular hog continued on back panel.

NOTICE


Before allowing birds to be processed remove band by cutting with shears. Place bands in metal container for disposal by burying or consigning to an agricultural chemical disposal site. Do not allow bands to enter the tankage or poultry waste containers.

CAUTION: Keep out of reach of children. Do not get in mouth. Harmful if swallowed. After prolonged storage, a small amount of liquid may form on the bands. Wipe bands with cloth before handling or applying. Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Do not contaminate feed, water or foodstuffs.
