DIRECTIONS: Place Flea Collar around dog's neck, adjust for proper fit and buckle in place. The collar must be worn loosely and in addition to the regular collar. If collar is worn too tightly, it may produce neck irritation. Cut off and dispose of the excess length. Flea kill begins at once and will continue for 3 months while the collar is worn. Ticks are harder to kill but those on the neck area will soon be killed and easily removed. Collar will continue to kill ticks for 8 weeks. For continuous protection, replace collar every 3 months.
