



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Hook flea tag to the small dog's (less than 20 lb.) collar and pinch "S" hook together. Flea kill begins at once and will continue for three months while tag is worn. Ticks are harder to kill, but those in the neck area will be killed in a short period of time after the tag is attached. For continuous protection replace tag every three months.

CAUTION: Do not open protective pouch until ready to use. Do not allow children to play with tag. The tag is intended for use only as an insecticide generator (U.S. Patents 2,833,073, 3,115,201, and 3,313,709), and is not to be taken internally by man or animals. Do not use on sick or convalescing dogs. Do not use on whippets or greyhounds. Do not use other pesticides on dogs while tag is worn. Remove the tag if any adverse reactions are observed. Some animals may be sensitive to this product.
