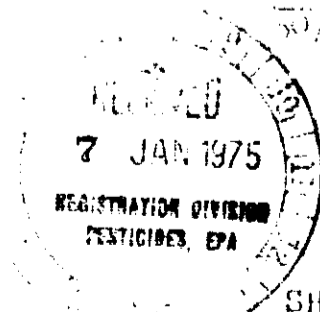
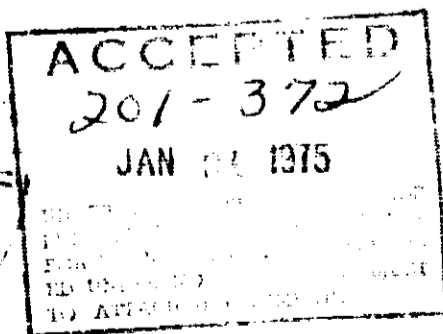
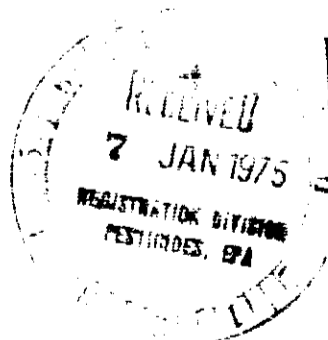

Indoors (Enlarge Print) Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps	Close doors and windows and spray upward in a sweeping motion to fill room with mist. Keep room closed for 15 minutes. Do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed. Spray directly on wasps.
