GENERAL DIRECTIONS

Always dilute BACTRO-CEN with water before using

To Sanitize Glassware, Silverware, Dishes, Cooking Utensils, etc. Clean with a suitable detergent, rinse thoroughly, then immerse in a sanitizing solution made with one ounce of BACTRO-CEN, to four gallons of water. Air-dry, do not use a towel. This solution is effective in water containing up to 550 ppm hardness. Follow the recommendations of your health department.

To Sanitize Dairy Equipment—Clean and rinse thoroughly. Then rinse with sanitizing solution containing one ounce of BACTRO-CEN to four gallons of water. Milk cans and other equipment should be air-dried. This solution is effective in water containing up to 550 ppm hardness. Follow the recommendations of your health department.

To Sanitize Equipment in Food Processing Plants, Including Meat Plants. Clean and rinse equipment thoroughly, then scrub with a solution of one ounce of BACTRO-CEN to four gallons of water. On surfaces difficult to clean completely, such as meat cutting boards, increase strength of disinfecting solution to one ounce to the gallon of water. Rinse with potable water before reuse.

Disinfecting: BACTRO-CEN is effective against *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*, PRD-10 ATCC No. 15442, in a dilution of 1 oz. per gallon of water, on hard non-porous surfaces. Rinse with potable water before reuse.

DANGER: Do not take internally. Harmful if swallowed. May cause skin irritation or damage to the eyes. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In cases of contact, flush immediately with plenty of water. For eyes, get medical attention. Avoid contamination of food. Do not get in eyes or on skin. Do not reuse empty container. Destroy it by perforating or crushing. Bury or discard in a safe place.
