FIRST AID: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting, drink large quantities of fluid and call a physician immediately.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Always dilute CEN-O-PHEN with water as indicated below.

For general cleaning, disinfecting and deodorizing of floors, furniture, equipment, walls, linens and other like inanimate objects, thoroughly wet surface with 1 part CEN-O-PHEN to 175 parts of water (approximately 3/4 oz. to the gallon of water). If higher detergency is desired, increase solution strength to 1%-2% (1 1/4-2 1/4 oz. per gallon of water).

CEN-O-PHEN has been tested and approved for use on conductive floors.

Quart 5.5 cc	1 Gallon 22 cc (approx. 3/4 oz.)	3 Gallons 65 cc (approx. 2 1/4 oz.)	5 Gallons 110 cc (3 3/4 oz.)
