

Hold dispenser upright. Spray toward center of room 3 to 5 seconds (deodorant) or 10 to 15 seconds (air sanitizer).

AS A MILDEW PREVENTATIVE:

Spray surface until moist.
Do not use on polished wood furniture or rayon fabrics.

Disposal

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
