DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Always dilute TRI-CEN with water as indicated below.

For general cleaning, disinfecting and deodorizing of floors, furniture, equipment, walls, basins, and other like inanimate objects, thoroughly wet surfaces with 1 PART **TRI-CEN** to 100 PARTS WATER (ONE AND ONE-FOURTH OUNCES TO THE GALLON OF WATER). If higher detergency is desired, increase solution to 2% (2½ oz. per gallon of water).
