

CEN-QUAT is a cleaner, disinfectant, and sanitizer, designed for institutional use, such as HOSPITALS, NURSING HOMES, AND SCHOOLS, where housekeeping will be of prime importance, in reducing the hazard of cross-infection. Hard surface sanitization can help in this reduction, and CEN-QUAT can provide the assurance you need in this area, when used as directed.

**DANGER:** Keep Out of Reach of Children. Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.
