USE DIRECTIONS:

Use of 2 ounces per gallon. This product will be effective against *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* PRO-1^o at this level.

This has been substantiated by the AOAC Use Dilution Confirmation Test.

At this level, the product is fungicidal against pathogenic fungi.

For best results, use CEN-QUAT with a cloth or mop and apply to walls and floors.

If used on food equipment or food contact items limit the level of active quaternaries to 200 ppm (2.8 ounces per 5 gallons).

Rinse with potable water before reuse.

For heavy soil or organic matter, a pre-cleaning step is recommended.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard.

FOR CLEANING CENTURY FIBERGLASS BATH AND THERAPY EQUIPMENT: To remove body oils, dead tissue, hard water and all other buildups of organic matter, apply CEN-QUAT in a dilution of one part CEN-QUAT to three parts water. Clean equipment with this dilution according to procedures recommended by Century Manufacturing Company and rinse thoroughly with clear water.
