

R-55 REPELLENT 18E is for use to repel Norway rats and house mice from established harborage and to deny their use of feeding and nesting trees and to reduce structural damage caused by Fox and Gray Squirrels. R-55 Repellent 18E repels rodents. IT DOES NOT KILL RODENTS. Its purpose is to keep rodents away from their harborage. Carefully read the attached brochure. The brochure contains explanation of the amount of material that space will not permit on the container label.

**EQUIPMENT FOR USE:** To prevent drips, etc., it is recommended solutions of R-55 Repellent 18E be applied with a pump-up tank type sprayer equipped with a valve that shuts off at the nozzle. The coarse spray recommended in this label can also be obtained with a Spray Systems Co. fan spray tip No. 8004 operating at 40 pounds pressure.

**ESTABLISHED HARBORAGE:** To repel rats from burrows and established harborage, apply R-55 Repellent 18E with 10 parts water or kerosene as a coarse spray. Wet the opening and into the burrow for a distance of 8 to 10 inches. Close the burrow with soil, re-spray the opening area until wet. When new openings appear, repeat the procedure. See attached brochure for additional information.

**ESTABLISHED HARBORAGE IN WALLS AND VOIDS OF BUILDINGS:** Spray the openings and cracks with R-55 Repellent solution. Give the rats an opportunity to leave the harborage before the hole or opening is closed. Avoid trapping rats in the walls.

**TEMPORARY BARRIERS:** To make a temporary barrier for plugging small holes or openings, saturate absorbent material, such as cotton socks or grain sacks, by spraying with R-55 Repellent solution. Let dry, then cut, roll or fold in such a size that will fill the opening. The treated material should be wedged into the opening in such a way that rats are required to chew their way through to remove.

**FOR LARGE OPENINGS:** Treat fiberboard. Cut board to size, then treat both sides by spraying with R-55 Repellent solution. Give special attention to the edge of the board as these will suffer the greatest attack. Do not use boards made of suitable pre-treated material.

**HOUSEHOLD USE:** **ESTABLISHED HARBORAGE:** Treat established harborage outside buildings for Norway Rats. Where dust and grass are a problem, frequent re-treatments may be required.

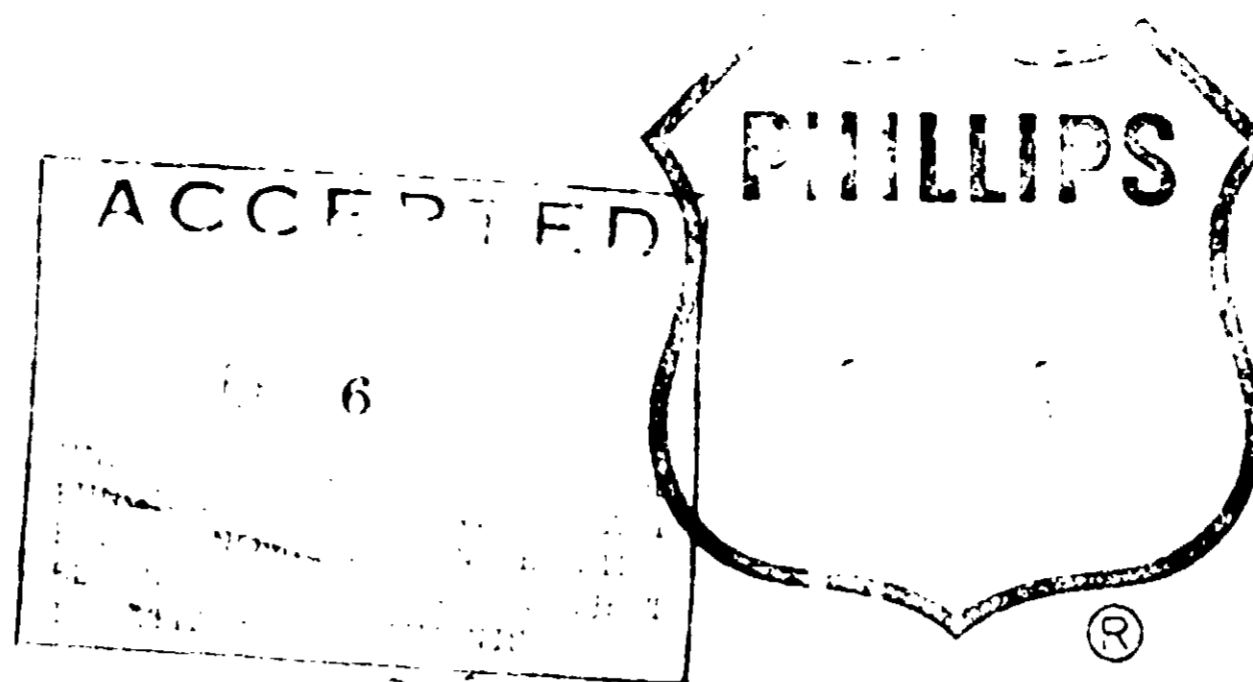
**FOX AND GRAY SQUIRRELS:** See instructions on the container label.

**WOOD DAMAGE:** To prevent wood damage to structural parts of wood, apply a 4:1 part R-55 Repellent 18E with 10 parts water. Use a coarse spray to the point of runoff. Since the surface of woods varies, painted, or unpainted, the time the application remains effective varies from 1 week to several months. Re-apply when the damage occurs. See brochure for supplementary instructions.

**SHINGLE ROOFS:** Spot treatment of a wood shingle roof sometimes results in moving the rodents to an untreated part of the roof. To treat the entire roof, apply 1 part R-55 Repellent 18E with 10 parts of water. Apply evenly to the roof until you have applied 1/2 pint of solution per square foot of roof area. At the time of application, shelter the amount of R-55 Repellent solution absorbed. Apply evenly at this rate. Re-apply when the label instructions. See brochure for more complete instructions.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Destroy it by perforating or crushing. Empty or discard in a safe place away from water.

**CAUTION:** Solutions of R-55 Repellent have low toxicity which may be harmful to aquatic life. Avoid application to water. Be certain that such applications are made in concentrated housing quarters, working areas, and industrial areas.

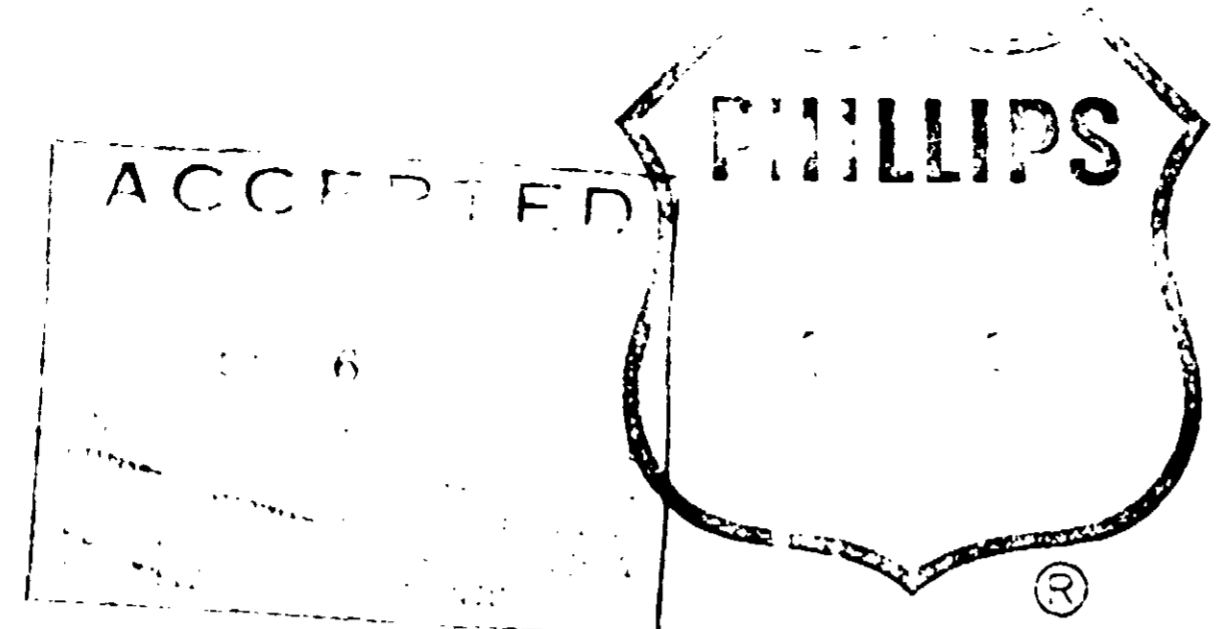
