R-55 REPELLENT 12.5E is for the treatment of soil surrounding buried cables to provide a repellent barrier against the plains pocket gopher. Geomys bursarius and the northern pocket gopher Thomomys talpoides.

Note: Plowing and applying R-55 Repellent 12.5E solution in areas of high water table will result in excessive dilution and will be ineffective

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Prepare R-55 Repellent 12 5E for use by diluting two gallons of R-55 Repellent 12.5E with 48 gallons of water. This is the minimum amount of R-55 Repetient and water recommended to treat one mile of caple-cables up to one inch diameter. For larger cables or multiple (3) cables placed in same trench double the amount R-55 solution will not harm high or low density polyethylene PVC, or most U.R.D. cable liackets. APPLICATION TO CABLES INSTALLED IN A TRENCH. After the cable (or cables) has been positioned in the trench, cover with approximately one inch of soil, then saturate this back fill with R-55 Repellent solution. More solution will be required to treat the cable in this type application because the area of soil treated is greater and precautions taken to avoid skips or insufficient treatment uses more solution. Application equipment used to apply R-55 solution to the trench may vary 'rom gravity flow type to large power equipment Care must be taken not to lift the cables out of the repellent treated soil during subsequent operations. 

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
