

- For both anti-microbial and anti-icing control, use in concentrations of 0.10 to 0.15% by volume. **Do not mix or blend this product with any fuels unless using a closed delivery system.** Blend with fuel continuously and incrementally with good mixing. Do not dump concentrated additive unmixed into fuel tanks. Do not allow concentrated additive to contact coated interiors of fuel tanks or painted surfaces.
