CAUTION

HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Avoid prolonged breathing of vapor, dust, or spray mist. Do not leave in eyes or on skin. Wash thoroughly after using. Avoid contamination of feed or foodstuffs. Avoid dusting feeding troughs or utensils. May cause irritation of nose and throat. May be absorbed through skin. Applicators must wear the following protective clothing during the application process: a light weight protective suit or coveralls; water-resistant hat; unlined waterproof gloves; and unlined, light-weight boots. CATTLE - Cattle Lice and Fleas: Dust the entire animal thoroughly. Repeat applications when necessary. Clean and dust stables and bedding. Keep untreated animals away from the treated cattle.

SHEEP and GOATS - Sheep Ticks and Lice: Dust the entire animal thoroughly and repeat applications in 4 or 5 weeks if any live ticks or lice are found at that time. Do not use on dairy goats.

HORSES - Lice, Fleas, Ticks & Mange: Dust animals thoroughly and repeat applications in 15 days. Treatment of bedding, pens or horses is necessary.

DOGS and WILF - Lice: Dust coat of animal thoroughly. Do not rub in, but leave on top of coat.

CATS - Lice, Fleas, and Ticks: Dust dogs with this material along the length of the back and work the powder in well. It is essential to clean and dust bedding or living quarters.

Subject: Amendment - Comply with Lindane Intent to Cancel
Tobacco States Brand Lice and Tick Powder
EPA Registration No. 226-40
Your Application Dated November 10, 1983

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. In the hazards to humans section revise the first three sentences to read: "Harmful if swallowed. May be absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing of dust. Do not get in eyes or on skin. Wash thoroughly after using and before eating or smoking."
2. A Statement of Practical Treatment must be added to the labeling. We suggest the following statement; however, if your toxicological data suggest otherwise, please submit a draft Statement of Practical Treatment for prior approval:

If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with a finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

If inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

If on skin - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

If in eyes - Flush eyes with plenty of water; Call a physician if irritation persists.

Handwritten notes and stamps in the bottom left corner, including the word "THREAT" and a small EPA logo.

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3. Delete the environmental hazards section as it is unnecessary for the labeled uses of the product.
4. Revise the text of the restricted use statement to read as follows (the statement in P14 is incorrect):

For retail sale to and use only by Certified Applicator or persons under their direct supervision and only for those uses covered by the Certified Applicator's certification.

Submit five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
