



Transplanter Solution

for use in

TRANSPLANTING WATER FOR PROTECTION AGAINST WIREWORMS attacking
TOBACCO and TOMATO PLANTS

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:

*Gamma isomer of Benzene Hexachloride from Lindane 10.0%

INERT INGREDIENTS:

90.0%

CAUTION: Keep out of reach of children

DANGER: Extremely flammable! Keep away from fire, sparks, and heated surfaces.

CAUTION

May be absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid skin contact. In case of contact, wash immediately with soap and water. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Do not use on household pets, or humans. Harmful if swallowed.

DIRECTIONS—Use only as directed.

TOBACCO STATES TRANSPLANTER SOLUTION is a special formulation made especially for use in transplanting water against wireworms. It should be mixed thoroughly with the water and will stay in suspension without agitation during the transplanting operation. The TRANSPLANTER SOLUTION establishes a zone of protection against wireworms around the roots of newly set plants. This allows the roots to develop and the new plants to become established.

TOBACCO—Wireworms: Use 2 to 4 fluid ounces in 50 gallons of transplanting water, depending on the type of soil. Apply at the rate of 1/2 pint to the plant or about 200 to 250 gallons of mixture to the acre.

TOMATOES—WIREWORMS: Use 1/4 pint in 50 gallons of transplanting water. Apply about 1/2 pint per plant or about 200 gallons per acre.

Rinse equipment and containers and dispose of wastes and spillage by burying in non-crop lands away from water supplies. Containers should be disposed of by perforating, crushing, and bury in non-crop lands away from water supplies.
