DIRECTIONS

General Information:

For best results apply when the weeds are small and the ground is moist after a rain. Use a coarse sprayer or sprinkling can when the air is still. Prevent spray drift and contact with desirable roots and plants. It produces top-kill only, so repeat applications are required for season long weed control of perennials. This product is non-selective in action. Its phytotoxic properties are quickly inactivated on contact with the soil. Do not use on established lawns, except for complete renovation as directed.

TO KILL ANNUAL WEEDS AND TOP GROWTH OF PERENNIAL WEEDS: For general weed control along sidewalks, driveways, fences, parking areas, around buildings and ornamentals and similar areas where non-selective action is wanted. Apply 4 quarts per 25 gals. of water. (For small amounts use 1 pint in 3 gals. of water) with a sprinkling can or coarse spray to the point of run-off. If regrowth occurs reapply as required.

MIXING INSTRUCTIONS — This product must be thoroughly dissolved with water. Fill the spray tank about one half full with water and add the required amount of this product with agitation. Finish filling with water and apply. Reagitate if allowed to stand. Clean equipment thoroughly by flushing with water. Mix only the amount needed to spray and leave none mixed up in the equipment.

DO NOT APPLY DIRECTLY OR ALLOW SPRAY TO COME IN CONTACT WITH FOILAGE, GREEN BARK, GRAFTED ONIONS, OR SCUFFED, DAMAGED OR BROKEN BARK WHEN SPRAYING AROUND TREES AND ORNAMENTALS. DO NOT CONTAMINATE WATERS USED FOR DOMESTIC CONSUMPTION, OR BY ANIMALS, WILDLIFE AND AQUATIC LIFE, OR FOR IRRIGATION PURPOSES. DO NOT GRAZE AREAS TO LIVESTOCK.

LAWN RENOVATION: Mow lawn to be renovated about 1 inch high before treatment. Mix 20 fluid ounces of this material in 4 gallons of water and apply to 1000 sq. ft. Cover foliage thoroughly, preferably on a warm sunny day. Foliage will usually turn brown in about five days. Bermuda grass and other deep-rooted perennials, or uncovered foliage, may require a second treatment. Reapply five days later if green areas remain. When foliage is all brown, matted areas should be raked and bare areas scarified. About five days after last treatment, water thoroughly and then seed at the rate recommended for new lawns. Seed must be raked into soil. Keep seeded areas well watered.

Kills annual weeds and top-kills perennial weeds such as:

<u>Muhlenbergia</u>	<u>bentgrass</u>	<u>timothy</u>	<u>oxalis</u>
<u>Bermuda grass</u>	<u>tall fescue</u>	<u>Knottweed</u>	<u>dandelion</u>
