

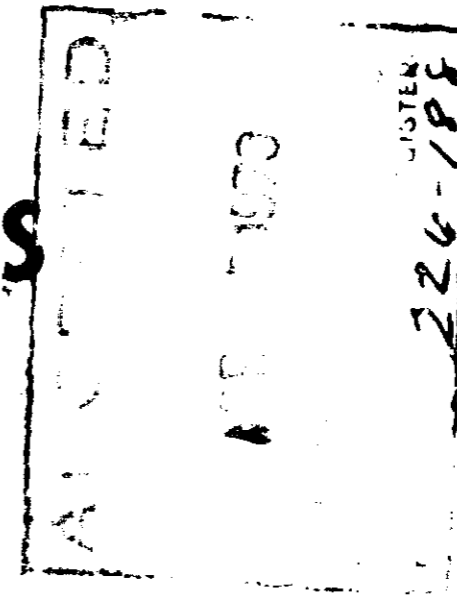
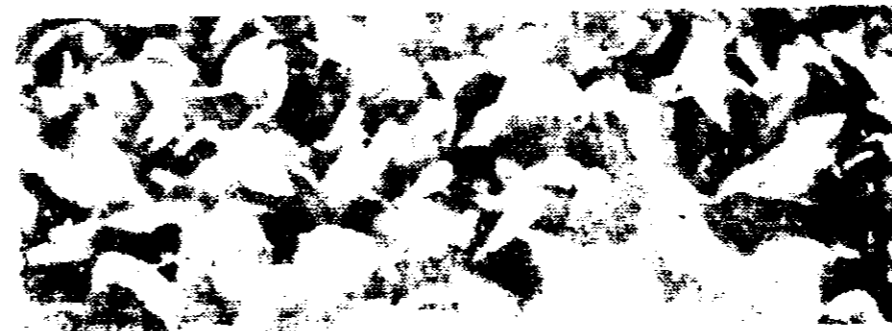

TOBACCO DISEASE AND INSECT DUST FOR PLANT BEDS

CAUTION: HARMFUL IF INHALED OR SWALLOWED. Avoid breathing of dust. Do not take internally. SKIN CONTACT MAY BE HARMFUL. Avoid skin contact. Wash hands and face before eating. AVOID CONTAMINATION OF FEED AND FOOD. Keep bag tightly closed and store in a dry place.

NOTE FOR PHYSICIAN: Carbarvl is a moderate, reversible, cholinestrase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal.

Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

DIRECTIONS FOR D & I DUST

For the control of Blue Mold, Anthrasnose and Flea Beetles. Dust at the rate of 1 to 2 pounds per 100 sq. yards. Heavier dose may cause plant injury. Begin applications when plants are about the size of a dime or when disease is first reported in the area. Repeat as necessary for insect control. For diseases repeat after a rain and repeat twice a week in extremely wet weather.

Do not reuse empty container. Destroy it by burying with waste or burning. Stay away from smoke or fumes.
