For use on Oilers and other backrubbing devices for the control of Horn Flies on Beef Cattle. Not to be used on dairy cattle.

Any arrangement of the slack or tight backrubber or oiler is suitable.

IMPORTANT: It takes several days to a couple weeks before cattle learn how to use oilers or backrubbers. If backrubber oil is not renewed and maintained, the cattle will quit using it. For good control of horn flies in summer and aid in reducing infestations of lice in winter keep the cattle using the backrubber charged with backrubber oil the year round. Do not use crankcase or lubricating oil. Do not permit animals access to treatment within 28 days of slaughter.

WARNING:

May be fatal if Swallowed! May be absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wash hands thoroughly after using. Do not contaminate food or food products. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not breathe vapor.

Do not use inside dairy barns, milk rooms or milk processing rooms. Do not use on dairy cattle, dairy goats, around feed or forage for animals or on animals being finished for slaughter. NEVER USE at rate stronger than recommended. Do not use on pets. Do not use in dwellings. Not for use or storage in or around the home.

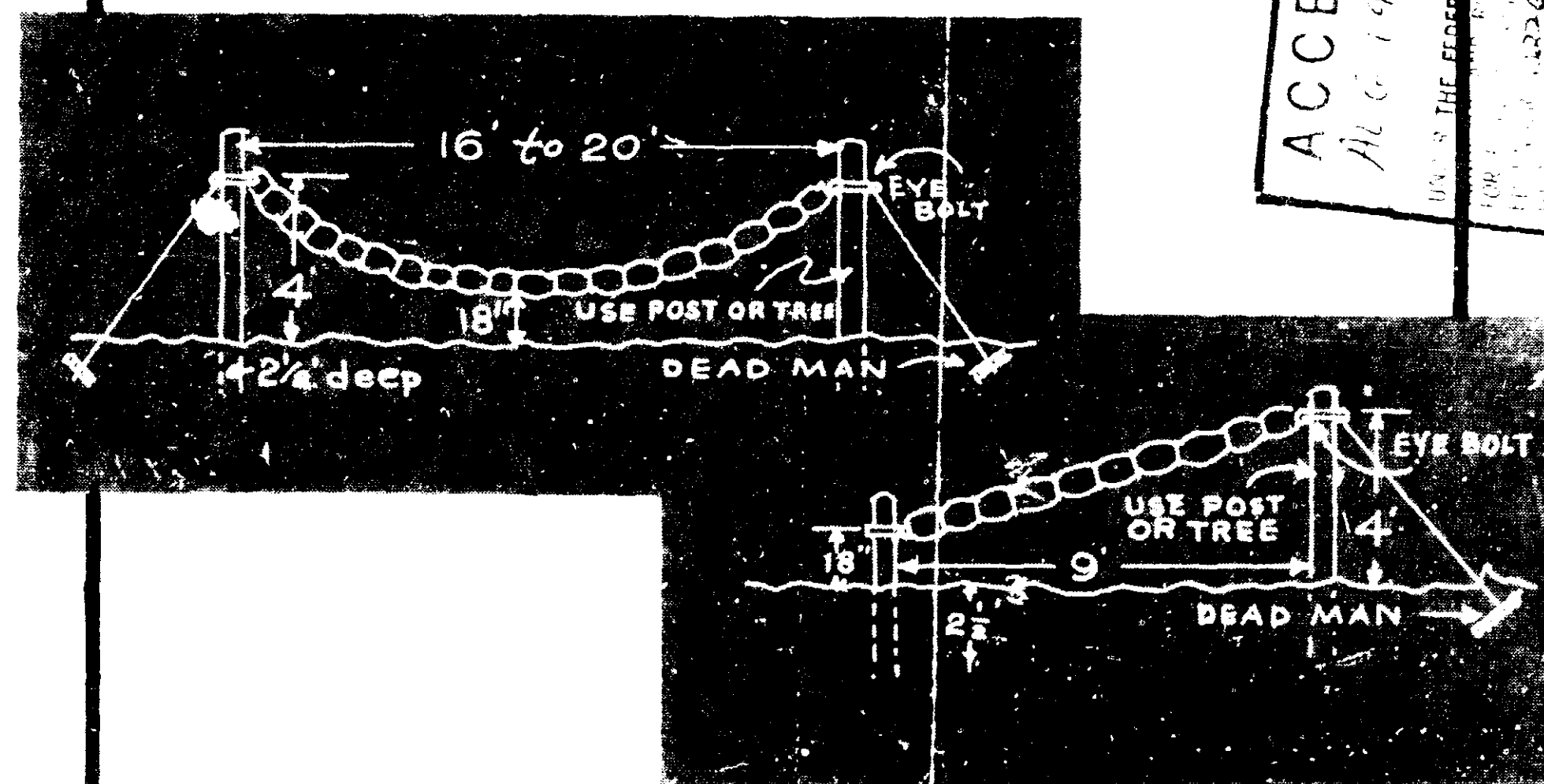

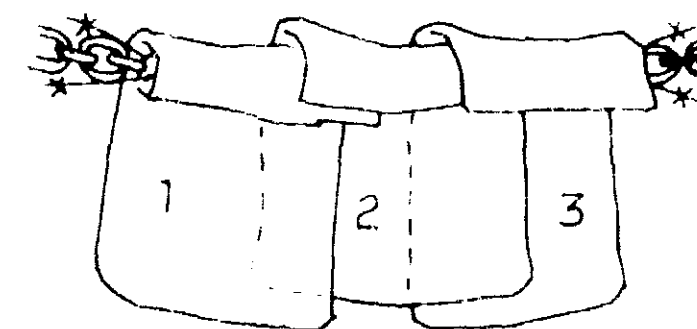

DIRECTIONS

STEPS:

1. Choose locations near watering places, mineral or salt stations, or any area where the cattle loaf.
2. Use quarter inch Chain, or Heavy Cable. The heavier the better.
3. Fasten chain to eye bolts in heavy posts or tree. (Use repair link, double snap swivels, or close eye around link)
4. Wrap two strands of Barbed wire around Chain. (Wrap second in opposite Direction to first). Secure ends in chain, or eye bolt.
5. Drape burlap sacks as shown in diagram. Wrap sack No. 1 once over chain; then No.2, then sack No. 3, etc. until all sacks have been wrapped around once. Go back to No. 1 and Repeat process until all sacks are completely rolled.
6. Tie each sack in "Waist" and in "Bulge" securely with binder twine.
7. Dilute 1 gallon of Backrubber Oil with 4 gallons of fuel or diesel oil.
8. Soak sacks with Diluted Backrubber Oil using 1 gallon to each 20 feet the first time. Renew about every two weeks with 2 qts. of diluted Backrubber Oil.
