Environmental Hazards

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

Storage and Disposal

Storage: Do not store in area of extreme heat or cold. Protect from moisture or extreme humidity.

Pesticide Disposal: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

Container Disposal: Do not reuse bag or can. Discard bag or can in trash.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Apply Dursban Ant Granules insecticide uniformly to home lawns and other ornamental and recreational turf grass areas using any hand or power operated gravity or rotary type spreader designed for application of granular materials. Treat when insects first appear using DURSCHAN ANT GRANULES at the rate of 200 pounds per acre. To help obtain uniform distribution apply one-half the required amount of product in one direction, then apply the balance at a right angle. Immediately after application sprinkle the turf with 1300 gallons of water per acre so as to wash the granules into the zone of insect infestation. Consult the following table to determine amounts of DURSCHAN ANT GRANULES and water needed for smaller sized areas. Repeat as necessary.

RATES TO USE

Area to be treated	Pounds of DURSCHAN ANT GRANULES	Gallons of Water to Sprinkle on Turf after treatment
1,000 sq. ft.	2	2
1,000 sq. ft.	5	30
5,000 sq. ft.	25	150
10,000 sq. ft.	50	325

To control certain white grubs (larvae of European chafer and Japanese beetle) use two to four times the amounts of DURSBAH ANT GRANULES shown in the table, i.e. 10 to 20 pounds per 1,000 sq. ft. Apply the granules uniformly over the area treated followed immediately by thorough watering to wash the insecticide into the turf. For best results treat when grubs are young and actively feeding near the soil surface, usually during late July and August. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service specialist for proper time to treat in your area.

To control Hyperodes (turfgrass) weevils use twice the rate of DURSBAH ANT GRANULES shown in the table. Treat suspected problem areas in mid-April and again in mid-May. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service specialist for best time to treat in your area.
