Household Application — For spot application only — Mix 5 oz. of Riverdale 50% Chlordane Wettable Powder in 1 gal. of water. This forms an effective spray solution (2%) to control: Ants, crickets, roaches, silverfish and water bugs. Thoroughly spray cracks and crevices, insect trails, hiding places and areas around door sills, window frames, openings around water pipes, heat ducts, baseboards and other locations where insects might enter. Spray on insects if possible. Repeat applications as necessary. Indoor use of this wettable powder may leave an unsightly residue.
