### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IMPORTANT: Read the entire label before using this product. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

Care must be taken to keep this herbicide away from desirable flower beds, lawns and shrubs. Do not apply over roots of valuable trees or woody ornamental plants. Only apply herbicide outside the dripline of trees. Toold spray drift to desirable plants.

Bare Ground Weed Control around: guard rails, airports, military installations, highway medians, pipelines, railroads, lumberyards, rights-of-way, buildings, storage areas, fences, pumps, machinery, fuel tanks, drainage ditchionks, recreation areas, roadways, industrial sites, light and power poles, fire hydrants, driveways, parking lots, walks, curbs, patios, and similar non-crop areas where plant growth is not desired.

Shake well and uniformly spray undiluted  $2\frac{1}{2}$  - 3 gals. per 1,000 sq. ft. (100-120 gals. per acre). Thoroughly wet all foliage to insure contact action. Best results are obtained when applications are made during or after weed emergence while growth is succulent. Where vegetation is tall and dense, use 5 gals. per 1,000 sq. ft. (200 gals. per acre). For control of hard-to-kill perennial weeds and grasses such as johnsongrass, bindweed and wild carrot, use 8-12 per 1,000 sq. ft. Although Riverdale Prometon 1.5 Vegetation Killer has considerable activity through foliar contact, much of its activity is through the roots and, therefore, adequate rainfall to move the chemical into the root zone is necessary.

Under conditions where the rainfall is high and the growing season long, a second application may be necessary to maintain a weed-free soil surface.

AS AN EDGING LIQUID: Shake well and uniformly spray i gallon per 60 sq. ft. of soil surface of a strip 4 inches wide, 180 feet long. To make a 4 inch band, hold applicator end about 6 inches from surface to be treated. To obtain wider band, rise container. Therefore the surface and stems of undesired vegetation to insure contact action.....

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: To be stored in original container and placed in an area inaccessible to children.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Product remaining in original container should be disposed of by securely wrapping original container in several layers of newspaper and discarding in trash.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Discard container in trash.

### Alternate Statements for Commercial Users

STORAGE: Always store pesticides in a secured warehouse or storage building. Do not store near seeds, fertilizers, insecticides, or fungicides. Containers should be opened in well-ventilated areas.
