The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act as amended is acceptable, provided you make the following changes before you release the product for shipment.

- 1. Change the order of precautionary statements to match the order of first aid statements, and organize both so that the order of the most severe routes of exposure are listed first.
- 2. Add "Users should wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet" under DIRECTIONS FOR USE in a User Safety Recommendations Box per the RED.
- 3. Add "Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift" in DIRECTIONS FOR USE section per the RED
- 4. Add "Do not enter or allow others to enter the treated area until dusts have settled" to DIRECTIONS FOR USE section per the RED.
- 5. Change the statement "Keep animals off treated areas" to "Keep children and animals off treated areas" under the DIRECTIONS FOR USE section.
- 6. Change "Storage" to "Pesticide Storage" under STORAGE AND DISPOSAL.
- 7. It is recommended that the statement "Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal" is moved to immediately under the heading "Storage and Disposal."
- 8. It is recommended that a PPE statement is added stating "Applicators and other handlers must wear long-sleeved shirt and long pants, shoes plus socks, and chemical resistant gloves" for good product stewardship.

Submit three (3) copies of final printed labeling incorporating the above changes before you release the product for shipment. Amended labeling will supercede all previously accepted ones. A stamped copy of labeling is enclosed for your records.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

NON-CROP WEED CONTROL - INDUSTRIAL USE ONLY

Riverdale 1% Bromacil Granular is a non-selective herbicide for controlling a wide range of annual and perennial weeds and grasses. It is recommended only for non-cropland areas such as rights-of-way for pipeline, utility, highway, and railroads; and industrial areas such as airports, petroleum tank farms, lumberyards, and plant sites. 800 to 1200 pound applications of Riverdale 1% Bromacil Granular per acre usually result in a non-productive condition of the soil for a period of a year or more. The duration of non-productivity is dependent upon rainfall, soil type, and other conditions. Do not apply more than 1200 lbs. (12 lbs. Bromacil A.I.) Per acre per year.

Riverdale 1% Bromacil Granular should be applied as furnished with a seed spreader, a fertilizer spreader, or with any equipment which will distribute the chemical uniformly over the area to be treated. For the Control of annual and most perennial weeds and grasses, apply Riverdale 1% Bromacil at the rate of 800 to 1200 pounds per acre; on smaller plots, 1.83 to 2.75 pounds per 100 square feet(12 lbs. Bromacil A.I. per acre per year). Repeat spot treatment may be required when deep-rooted perennial weeds are present. To obtain the best results, Riverdale 1% Bromacil granular should be applied to the ground where it will be absorbed by the roots. Applications made early in the season have been found to give results superior to applications at a later seasonal date. Riverdale 1% Bromacil Granular may, however, be applied at any time of the year. Maximum effectiveness in arid regions is obtained when application is made just prior to the rainy season. Users should consult state agricultural experimental stations or extension service weed specialists for recommendations as to use in their particular area.

IMPORTANT: (NOT FOR RESIDENTIAL USE). Do not apply on or near valuable woody or herbaceous plants or on areas where their roots may extend because of possible injury to such plants. Thoroughly clean spreading equipment with a suitable chemical cleaner before using for other purposes (or do not use same spreading equipment for other purposes). Do not use on croplands or any land to be used for subsequent cropping. Keep animals off treated areas.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Always store pesticides in a secured warehouse or storage building. Do not store near feed or foodstuff. To prevent cross-contamination, do not store near open containers of fertilizer, seed or other pesticides. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Completely empty liner by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then dispose of liner and drum in a sanitary landfill or by incineration if allowed by state and local authorities. If drum is contaminated and cannot be reused, dispose of in the same manner.
