areas such as rights-of-ways for pipeline, utility, highway, and railroads; and industrial areas such as airports, petroleum tank farms, lumberyards, and plant sites. 200 to 400 pound applications of Riverdale 4% Bromacil Granular per acre usually result in a non-productive condition of the soil for a period of a year or more. The duration of non-productivity is dependent upon rainfall, soil type, and other conditions.

Riverdale 4% Bromacil Granular should be applied as furnished with a seed spreader, a fertilizer spreader, or with any equipment which will distribute the chemical uniformly over the area to be treated.
