This pesticide is toxic to fish, aquatic invertebrates, and aquatic life stages of amphibians. For terrestrial uses, do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. BEEF CATTLE and DAIRY CATTLE (Non-lactating): Lice, Ticks and Horn Flies (Face flies) - make thorough and liberal application to all parts of animal's body by hand or power duster. Rub in lightly to carry powder beneath the hair. Repeat application at 14 day intervals. DO NOT APPLY TO LACTATING DAIRY CATTLE. Do not treat young animals under 3 months of age.

HOGS: Lice - Make thorough and liberal application to all parts of the animal by hand or power duster as well as pen and litter. After treatment hogs should be kept out of the sun or wind for a few hours. Repeat in 10 days if necessary. Do not treat animals under one month of age.

POULTRY (Chickens, Ducks, Geese and Turkeys): Lice and Mites - Premise Treatment - For control of chicken red mite, northern fowl mite and poultry lice, apply 1 lb. per 50 to 60 sq. ft. of litter and floor space up to nests, roosts and adjacent areas.

Bird Treatment - Apply directly to individual birds (including areas of vent, fluff and under wings) by means of a shaker can or rotary duster. Repeat in 4 to 8 weeks or when necessary. Treatment is supplemental to premise treatment for chicken red mite.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in original container and place in a cold dry location. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Completely empty container into application equipment. Then dispose of empty container in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
