On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

2. Submit acceptable primary eye irritation and primary skin irritation studies performed with this product. We acknowledge that studies submitted to fulfill this requirement were received by the Agency on May 18, 1994 and are currently pending review.

3. Make the following label changes before you release the product for shipment:

- a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 228-284".
- b. Add the statements "Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Causes eye irritation" to the beginning of the Precautionary Statements. To prevent redundancy, the statement "Harmful if swallowed or inhaled" may be deleted from the middle of the section.

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c. Add the statement "Get medical attention" to the end of the IF ON SKIN statement within the Statement of Practical Treatment.

d. Add the following statements to the Statement of Practical Treatment:

"IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or poison control center. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person."

"IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth. Get medical attention."

e. We have noted that the Net Contents are expressed in pounds and ounces. According to our records, however, this product is a liquid. Therefore, the Net Contents statement should be expressed in terms appropriate to the measure of a liquid.

4. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for the record before you release this product for shipment.

USE PRECAUTIONS

Do not use this product for controlling weeds in flower or vegetable beds or around shrubs or ornamental plantings. Do not spray roots of desirable trees and plants. Do not spray on Dichondra, Lippia, nor on grasses where desirable Clovers are present. Do not apply to newly seeded grasses until they have been mowed 3 times. Do not cut grass 1 to 2 days before and after application. Do not reseed for 3 to 4 weeks after use. If lawn needs watering, water thoroughly before application. Do not water for 48 hours after application. Watering will wash off weed killing material. Do not apply if rainfall is expected within 48 hours. Avoid fine mists. Spray when air is calm to avoid spray drift that might injure desirable ornamental plants. Do not apply when temperature exceeds 90°F. Shake well before using.

After applying this product, many broadleaf weeds will begin to show visible signs of leaf curl within a few days. Some hard-to-control broadleaf weeds may require a second (or an additional) treatment.

This product contains a foam which marks the spot where the weed killer has been applied.

DIRECTIONS

1. Shake can just before using and occasionally during use.
2. Invert can, hold at arm's length, and point can at weed as you press button. Do not press button when can is in upright position.
3. Stand close to weed (1 to 2 feet) with can aimed at weed and away from face.
4. Push down briefly on button. Spray to cover center of weed, do not over-spray. The spray's foaming action will make it easy for you to see coverage.
5. One application will kill most weeds listed. If certain tough weeds are not dead within 3 weeks, repeat application.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep from freezing. To be stored in original container and placed in an area inaccessible to children. Do not store near heat or open flame.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Product remaining in original container should be disposed of by securely wrapping original container in several layers of newspaper and discarding in trash.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Do not incinerate or puncture. Replace cap and discard container in trash.
