The Agency has completed its review of the revised basic Confidential Statement of Formula, dated January 9, 2007 and has determined that it is acceptable. The amended basic CSF will supersede the current basic CSF, dated June 15, 1998.

The label amendment referred to above, submitted in accordance with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following provisions:

1. Add the following statement under the name of the product: "For Use on Lawn/Turf Only".

Do not spray on Dichondra, Lippia, nor on grasses where desirable Clovers are present. Do not apply to newly seeded grasses until they have been mowed 3 times. Do not cut grass 1 to 2 days before and after application. Do not reseed for 3 to 4 weeks after use. If lawn needs watering, water thoroughly before application. Do not water for 48 hours after application. Watering will wash off weed killing material. Do not apply if rainfall is expected within 48 hours. Avoid fine mists. Spray when air is calm to avoid spray drift that might injure desirable ornamental plants. Do not apply when temperature exceeds 90°F. Shake well before using.

DIRECTIONS

- 1. Shake can just before using and occasionally during use.
- 2. Invert can, hold at arm's length, and point can at weed as you press button. Do not press button when can is in upright position.
- 3. Stand close to weed (1 to 2 feet) with can aimed at weed and away from face.
- 4. Push down briefly on button. Spray to cover center of weed, do not over-spray. The spray's foaming action will make it easy for you to see coverage.
- 5. One application will kill most weeds listed. If certain tough weeds are not dead within 3 weeks, repeat application.
