Veteran™ CST Herbicide is a specially formulated product for control of trees and their sprouts in forest and non-cropland areas, such as along roads, ditchbanks and rights-of-way. This product requires no dilution or mixing. Apply directly to freshly cut surfaces of trees such as: Allanthus, Alder, Ash, Aspen, Basswood, Birch, Cedar, Cherry, Cottonwood, Fir, Gum, Hawthorn, Hickory, Hornbeam, Maple, Oak, Persimmon, Red maple, Sycamore, Sweetbay, Willow.

IMPORTANT: Do not contaminate irrigation ditches of water used for drinking. Do not apply to areas where the possible downward movement of the product may cause contact of Veteran CST with the roots of desirable plants. Desirable plants, trees and shrubs, may also be affected by root uptake or herbicide damage to roots of nearby treated trees. Therefore, do not use Veteran CST unless possible injury can be tolerated.

APPLICATION DIRECTIONS

FRILL OR GIRDLE TREATMENTS: Make a continuous cut or a series of cuts using an axe to girdle tree trunk. Spray or paint cut surface with the product. **STUMP TREATMENTS:** Spray or paint freshly cut surface with the product. The area adjacent to the bark should be thoroughly wet.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

STORAGE: Store in original container in a well-ventilated area separate from foodstuffs. Avoid cross-contamination with other pesticides. Spills should be contained and absorbed with clay granules, sawdust, or equivalent material.
