This product requires no dilution or mixing and can be applied directly to freshly cut surfaces of trees such as: Ailanthus, Alder, Ash, Aspen, Basswood, Birch, Cedar, Cherry, Cottonwood, Dogwood, Elm, Fir, Gum, Hawthorn, Hickory, Hornbeam, Maple, Oak, Persimmon, Poplar, Sassafras, Serviceberry, Sourwood, Sumac, Sweetbay, Sycamore, Willow.

IMPORTANT: Do not contaminate irrigation ditches of water used for domestic purposes.
