Label Amendment for RED: 2,4-D, and Dicamba

Riverdale Millennium Ultra Granular Weed Killer

EPA Registration Number 228-344

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended is acceptable provided that you:

- 1. The text "Wear long pants, long-sleeved shirt, socks and shoes when applying this product. After using the product, remove clothing and launder separately before reuse, and promptly and thoroughly wash hands and exposed skin with soap and water" appearing in the section entitled Hazard to Humans and Domestic Animals is either incomplete or duplicated elsewhere on the label and should be deleted.
- 2. Per the combined 2,4-D/Dicamba label table, "chemical-resistant gloves made of any waterproof material" must be added to the handler PPE section.
- 3. It is unclear whether this product is intended for sod farm use. The label must either be revised to include exclusionary text such as "Not for use on turf grown for sale or other commercial use as sod, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes" or include an Agricultural Use Requirements box that lists an REI of 48 hours and early entry PPE (coveralls worn over short-sleeve shirt and short pants, chemical-resistant footwear plus socks, chemical-resistant gloves made of any waterproof material, chemical-resistant headgear for overhead exposure and protective eyewear.")
- 4. The text "Do not allow people (other than the applicator) or pets on treatment area during application. Do not enter treatment areas until dust has settled" and "The maximum number of broadcast applications per treatment site is 2 per year" should be relocated to the Directions for Use.

5. The following text must be added to the label:

"Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during application."

- 6. The directions to apply "4 (or 3.6 for 18 lb Bag) pounds per 1000 square feet" (or 1.99 lb ae of 2,4-D per acre) exceeds the allowable rate of 1.5 lbs of 2,4-D ae per acre per application. The label must be revised.
- 7. Please note: Final product reregistration cannot be considered until after all active ingredients in this product are eligible for reregistration.

WHEN TO APPLY: Best results are obtained when weeds are growing actively in spring or early fall. Avoid contact with desirable shrubs, plants, vegetables, or flowers; especially when applying with a rotary (spinner) type spreader. Do not reseed for at least 3 to 4 weeks after application. Do not apply to newly seeded or sodded lawn until after 3 mowings. For optimum results (1) Avoid mowing 1 to 2 days before and after application; (2) Apply when grass is moist (after a rain, sprinkling or dew); (3) Avoid unnecessary disturbances, including watering of treated areas for 48 hours after application. Watering will wash off weed killing material; and (4) Avoid applying if rainfall is expected within 48 hours following treatment. Possible retreatment in approximately 30 days may be necessary if lawn is heavily overrun with weeds or if adverse low moisture conditions prevail and weeds are in a state of poor growth. Do not exceed recommended rates because damage to turf may occur.

NOTE: When applying to listed Warm Season Grasses - under conditions of inadequate moisture, high temperature and high humidity, over-application may cause minor transitory discoloration. It is recommended that during hot, dry conditions, application rates should be reduced 50% to avoid possible dehydration or browning of grass.

HOW TO APPLY: This 20 (or 18) pound bag should be used on 5,000 square feet. Apply evenly with a lawn spreader as a one pass application. A two pass application, criss-crossing the area at half the rate each time is also acceptable.

The following settings are <u>approximate</u> for applying contents of this package at a suggested rate of 4 (or 3.6 for 18 lb. Bag) pounds per 1,000 square feet. Settings are based on an average walking speed. Reduce setting for slower speed; raise setting for higher speed. Check your spreader on 250 square feet and adjust to apply at the rate of 1 (.9 for 18 lb. Bag) pound per 250 square feet.

Wash out spreader after each use and allow it to dry thoroughly. Treat any exposed metal spreader areas with oil to reduce corrosion.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
