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## COMPATIBILITY

Eclipse Selective Herbicide can be mixed with some liquid fertilizers or liquid iron materials. Because liquid fertilizers and liquid iron differ in pH, free ammonia content, density, salt concentration and percentage of water, a compatibility test (given below) is recommended prior to mixing in the application equipment. All regulations, either State or Federal, relating to the application of liquid fertilizers or liquid iron and this product must be strictly followed. The following compatibility test should always be performed prior to full-scale mixing.

- 1. Pour 18 ounces of water into a quart jar.
- 2. Add 1 ounce of either the liquid fertilizer or liquid iron to be used.
- 3. Add 1 ounce of Eclipse Selective Herbicide.
- 4. Close jar and shake well.
- Watch the mixture for several seconds after shaking and check again after 30 minutes.
